INTRODUCTION

Brahmana as a Scholar, Teacher, Priest, Poet etc. has followed the Hindu Traditions which enjoined him to live a life of Learning, Teaching and Non-Possessiveness. True to the tradition enjoined in “Sanatana Dharma”, since known traceable history, Brahman community has led a serene and sacrificial life wishing welfare of entire society irrespective of Caste, Religion, Region etc. They mostly led a spiritual life and have not given much importance to materialistic gains. The Brahmin was bestowed with intellect and worked for spiritual elevation of entire society and the society in turn respected and nurtured the Brahmin in reciprocation, with great reverence. However, Western culture and caste based selfish motivated politicians have cornered the Brahman community from every angle, leaving majority of Brahmins in pathetic condition, irrespective of their position. Added to the above external threats and prevailing adverse situation, the ego and so called intellect have not allowed the community to function as a cohesive group, leaving individuals to suffer.

There are many Brahmin Associations in various states and districts all over India which are either sub-sect based or serving the Brahmin community in a limited way. We have many resourceful persons with missionary zeal to help the community but their resources cannot be utilized by the needy in the absence of a Global Platform and to make the Brahmins into a unified force. It was therefore considered essential to establish a strong International Organisation and create a common global platform for Brahmins cutting across barriers of sub sects, regions and languages. Such an organization will inspire the community and will become a beacon

to the oppressed and suppressed Brahmin Community of today for generations to come and herald the Golden era of the yore where the Brahmin will be given his respectable place in the society for his knowledge of Vedas, rituals and simplicity. This will in turn stem the rot that has set in the society and herald a clean society with morals and ethics.

With above views, Dr P Kamalakara Sharma, Managing Director of Sree Raghavendra Hospitals, Mylardevpally, Rajendranagar Mandal, R.R.District, Hyderabad with a few likeminded Medical Doctors has established **Dhanwantari Foundation International** (DFI), a trust formally registered at Sub Registrar’s Office of Rejendra Nagar Mandal, R.R.District, Hyderabad in April, 2004.

The organisation has grown manifold ever since establishment and shaped into a true International platform with lakhs of Members from all the States of India and more than 22 countries all over the World. The Trust is administered by nine highly respectable Trust Board Members. The Membership includes Doctors, IAS, IPS, IRS, IFS, IRTS, Defence officers, Management Professionals from IIMs, Educationists, Chartered Accountants, Advocates, Engineers, Bankers, Poets, Fine Arts, Cinema, Architects, Businessmen, Investment Consultants, Market Analysts, House Wives, Purohits etc from the Brahmin community.

MAIN MISSION

The Main Mission of Dhanwantari Foundation International is **“Creating a common global platform of Brahman community, which enables the intellectuals and professionals of our community to extend various services to uplift Brahman community in particular and society in general”**.

AIMS & OBJECTIVES

The Aims & Objectives of Dhanwantari Foundation International are:

- 1) To establish various educational & professional institutions like Veda Pathasalas, Sanskrit Colleges, Medical Colleges, Engineering Colleges, Arts Colleges, various professional colleges and research institutions etc., and establish a deemed university so

that our community people will utilize the services for better positioning themselves in the society irrespective of their economic status.

- 2) To establish vocational training and self employment generating institutes to help large number of poor unemployed youth of our community.
- 3) To create health service facilities, also within the reach of poorer strata of our community.
- 4) To develop entrepreneurship qualities among community and train them to self-employment generation and be able to start their own establishments.
- 5) To establish strong global network by developing database of all members of our community so that it will be useful for common benefits such as employment opportunities, marriage alliances, tie-ups with insurance companies for healthcare services etc.
- 6) To establish trust hospital-cum-old age homes at all possible centers to help the helpless old people of our community to live in a peaceful atmosphere at fag end of their life.
- 7) To establish hostels for students, working men and women in various centers.
- 8) To publish a magazine giving information of various facilities, day-to-day developments of DFI etc.
- 9) To uplift temple purohiths who are living under very pathetic conditions and strengthen them so that they can guide the rest of the community to live in accordance with true moral code of Brahmans.
- 10) Ultimately, groom the community into a unified force to reckon with and influence every sphere of public life in India and abroad to attain a respectable status in the Society.

PRESENT PROGRESS

Passing through many initial hurdles, peculiar to our community, DFI has successfully achieved its primary and fundamental target of land procurement for establishing various facilities as enumerated in the Aims & Objectives. About 450 Acres of land at Midjil near

Jedcharla, Mahaboob Nagar District of AP and 1500 Acres at Ananthsagar, near Siddipet abutting Hyderabad-Karimnagar State highway is purchased from land owners, to date. About 3000 members have participated in procurement of land with a contribution of one lakh rupees each. Initial 490 members were enrolled as Governing Council Members, next 398 members as Donor-I members and next 620 members as Donor-II members. The above category of Members were also given back some farm land and a residential plot of land of 1000 or 500 Sq Yds in the Main Agraharam that is planned around the Main DFI complex to be built at Ananthsagar Village near Siddipet, Medak District of Andhra Pradesh, as a token of acknowledgement of their donation for the cause.

Though what is achieved so far is unprecedented and remarkable, what is yet to be achieved in future is still a very big challenge. DFI's aim is to bring every Brahmin worldwide under one umbrella and increase the membership into crores.

At Midjil, preliminary land development like cutting and cleaning bushes, leveling of land, boundary fixing by stone khadis and barbed wire fencing, internal road formation, earmarking of farmland plots of members etc. was completed. A Master Plan of Educational Institutions campus at Midjil has been developed. The Foundation Stone was laid for building "**Dhanwantari Aarsha Adhunika Wignana Nilayam (DAWN)**" at Midjil Trust Land by His Holiness Sreemad Abhinavoddanda Sri Sri Sri Vidya Nrisimha Bharatee Swamyji, Peethadhipati of Sree Pushpagiri Mahasamsthan at 8.43 AM on Sunday the 20th March 2011.

Similarly the Master plan for Siddipet with the Main International Brahmin Headquarters, Deemed University, Vedic & Sanskrit Colleges, Medical, Engineering Colleges, Super Speciality Hospitals, Old-age Homes, Vocational Training colleges and all other facilities that are planned, will come up and will be co-located with the Agraharam where Members will lead a serene and peaceful life.

MEMBERSHIP OF DFI

Membership is open to all Brahmans irrespective of their subsect since the aim of DFI is to bring all Brahmans anywhere in the World on to a common platform. The entire Membership amount is

invested in fixed deposits in a scheduled bank and the interest accrued on it is spent for running the trust activities.

Life Membership:

The Membership is open to all Brahmins and the DFI reserves its right to accept or reject any Membership application if the conduct of the applicant is not commensurate with **THE MORAL CODE OF CONDUCT OF A BRAHMIN**. The details of Life Membership are given below as guidelines and the applicants may clarify any doubts with the nearest branch of DFI.

(a) Life Membership Fee. The Printed Application of DFI with the serial number only should be filled up by the applicant and pay Rs.1,500/- by cheque or DD payable at Hyderabad towards Life Membership. The amount can also be deposited directly into DFI account with Union Bank of India, Himayatnagar Branch, Hyderabad, A/C No. **327602010092552**. Overseas applicants can complete the Membership form on line at our website www.dhanwantri.org and submit the form **online along with a digital photo. The amount can also be paid on line.**

(b) Submission. The completed application form along with Photograph, Blood Group and payment can be submitted in the nearest Branch of DFI or at the Administrative Office at Hyderabad.

(c) Advantages of Life Membership. The advantages of Life Membership over General Membership are as below:

- ❖ Issue of Internationally Valid DID (Identity Card) with a Member Directory of Professionals like Doctors, Chartered Accountants, Industry owners etc at various places.
- ❖ 20-25 % discount on all services and goods of Members in the directory
- ❖ Eligible for nomination to the Professional Committees based on their expertise and qualification.
- ❖ Eligible for investments in Commercial companies of DFI Group.
- ❖ Eligibility for allotment of Farmland/Residential Plot in Agraharam
- ❖ Regular mail service through e-Mails and snail mails.
- ❖ Enrollment in subsidized Group Health Insurance to be started soon.

General Membership:

Any Brahmin irrespective of the sub-sect can become a General Member by filling up the prescribed Application Form of DFI and by payment of Rs.20/- in cash towards the Membership fee. The application may be submitted in any Branch of the DFI along with the cash and a receipt obtained for the amount. The General Members can avail various services provided by DFI like Swayamvaram, Updhi (Employment), Tailoring, Vocational Training, Student Scholarships etc. as per the terms and conditions prescribed from time to time. They will also be entitled to Health Card facility as and when the service is commenced. Members should contact the nearest Branch or Administrative Office at Hyderabad for details.

Affiliated Membership

The Affiliated Membership is open to all other local Brahmin Associations to facilitate bringing all Brahmins onto the common platform. They are welcome to continue their independent identity and continue the good services being rendered by them to the community. The local Brahmin Association will be offered affiliation of DFI so that through the individual Brahmin Associations, all the benefits of DFI can be extended to their own Members. The affiliation will be extended through **Dhanwantari Foundation International Brahmin Jagruti** on payment of Rs.5,001/- as a one time basis. Immediately after affiliation, the existing facilities of DFI will be extended to the Brahmin Association through the local Branch of DFI. Full details can be had from the Administrative office at Hyderabad.

DFI SERVICE ACTIVITIES

Whilst the Trust is pursuing the Main Mission vigorously, it is considered essential to provide certain essential services to the community and address various welfare measures. We invite philanthropic Members to come forward with a helping hand so that the Trust is not overburdened. The details of Various services provided by DFI are given below.

DFI Swayamvaram (Marriage Bureau)

Finding suitable Brides and Grooms as life partners within the community will preserve our traditions and culture. Girl child infanticide has worsened the situation and many boys are forced to remain bachelors or seek life partners from other communities. DFI Swayamvaram Trust conducts conventions once in a fortnight in various Districts and once in a quarter at the State Capital Hyderabad. This is facilitating prospective Brides and Grooms to find their Life Partners. DFI has designed high tech Digital Display, Web search, and distribution of Convention books at considerable cost. A year planner is published in Dhanwantari Vani for advance information. DFI Swayamvaram also provides Premier Services to interested Members by finding suitable matches regularly till the marriages are settled. Swayamvaram has settled 2500 marriages so far. DFI Upadhi (Employment)

Brahmin children are denied Government jobs due to the prevailing reservations. Merit has no criteria. A survey report published in the Media indicates that 75% of Brahmins are unemployed. Under the circumstances, it is essential to run Upadhi services. Every effort is made by DFI Upadhi to identify employers/companies headed by Brahmins and bring the unemployed together. This is fairly successful. Members who own Industries and Organisations may come forward and intimate the vacancies. Similarly unemployed Members of our community may register with DFI Upadhi for various opportunities. Upadhi services at District level require a push from the Members so that local employment can be given to the unemployed instead of calling them to the state capital. Till date over 500 jobs were provided through this wing. For Registrations and details Members may contact Tel Nos. 040-27551915 or 27552482.

DFI Niramayam (Health Services)

Healthcare and treatment in corporate hospitals has gone out of reach of more than 80% of our community. We have more than 1500 doctor members and not a single Super Speciality Hospital of our own. Very soon, we will have a super speciality hospital of our own. One of the Members has donated one crore rupees to start a Neuro wing in the Memory of his daughter who died in a road accident. Plans are afoot to form Professional Committees and also establish a super speciality hospital in each District to provide affordable treatment to the Members of our community. Group Insurance and Health cards for Members are being planned.

A number of Medical camps are conducted in remote villages with our specialist doctors to provide succour not only to our Members but also to the poor villagers who cannot afford specialist attention and admission. Free medicines are also distributed during the camps. We invite donors irrespective of their caste and community to render a helping hand financially to conduct the Health camps. More than 8000 patients were given counselling through about 32 medical camps conducted through DFI on its own and along with Lions Club, Secundrabad. Apart from these OP treatment in camps, many inpatient services are coordinated for our community members through the network of DFI Doctors' healthcare establishments like Clinics, Diagnostic Centres, Nursing homes and Hospitals through various Branches of DFI.

Scholarships for Students

Due to the prevailing reservation policies, the children of 55% Brahmin population living below poverty line are forced to discontinue the studies at Intermediate level. The survey report published in “**Brahmins of India**” (Chug Publications) indicates that 44% of Brahmin children are discontinuing studies at Primary Level and 36% are not going beyond tenth class mainly because of the economic conditions. This is a matter of shame that the brilliant children can’t pursue their studies or go for coaching classes for appearing in the competitive exams. The scholarship scheme of DFI provides financial assistance to the children to pursue Technical, Non-Technical, Graduation and Post Graduation courses. The scheme requires generous contributions from the Members. Hundreds of children above 80% scores are awaiting assistance in spite of DFI giving lakhs of Rupees as financial assistance based on merit and economic conditions. DHANWANTARI BHAVANS

All service needs of Brahmin community from Birth to Departure- “**JANMAADI JARAA PARYANTAM AALAMBANA**” – are planned under one roof. The concept is to create all the above services of DFI under one roof and also create a gated community for Brahmin Members to live in 1 BHK, 2 BHK or 3 BHK apartments. The DFI Bhavan

will provide all the services not only to the Members residing inside but for all Brahmin Members residing in the cities and Districts where they are located. In fact, the DFI Branches will be located in the Bhavan. In addition to the services mentioned above, DFI Bhavan will also have function hall(s), Crèche, Old Age Home, Hostel, Medical Hall, Upahar etc. The first-ever DFI Bhavan is coming up at Champapet, Hyderabad in an area of 6,100 Sq Yds with Fifty 3 BHK apartments for the Members to reside in the gated community.

In addition to self-financing the construction of the apartments, the Bhavan facilities will be built with the funds pooled in by the Members. The investors will share 80% of profits in proportion to their investments and balance 20% net profit will be donated to the Bhavan to run all the services of DFI. PROFESSIONAL COMMITTEES

DFI will continue to be administered by the Board of Trustees and will not resort to elections. However it will not be possible for the Administrative office to remotely oversee the functioning of the Branches in other States and Districts, from Hyderabad. It is therefore decided to form committees of each profession like Doctors, Advocates, Chartered Accountants etc and nominate the consensus Member as the coordinator for that particular profession. All the coordinators from various professions will form the local Advisory Committee and the consensus candidate will be requested to be the Convenor of the Advisory Committee. The Professional Committees will meet as often as possible and devise various schemes to render service to the Members residing in the area. The Advisory Committee under the convenor will oversee running of the local Branch which may be located in the Dhanwantari Bhavan Complex as and when it comes up in the local Branch Area. They will also oversee overall development of DFI Branch and increase the Membership at Mandal and Village Levels. They will also help the Branch In-charge to

coordinate various professional services to all DFI Members in that area. Please contact the Managing Trustee or the Manager regarding willingness to form part of the Professional Committee or Advisory Committee.

COMMERCIAL COMPANIES

One of the Aims & Objectives of DFI is to promote entrepreneur qualities amongst the Brahmins and make them economically strong. The companies will also provide employment to thousands of Brahmin unemployed youth who are denied Government Jobs due to the existing Reservations Policy. Secondly, no Trust like DFI can run on a perpetual basis on the donations from Members. The commercial companies set up under the overall umbrella of DFI will use a common logo and utilise the marketing services of DFI network. The companies already set up so far and to be set up in future will function under the following guidelines:

- a) None of the DFI Trust funds will be used either to establish or to run the commercial companies.
- b) DFI Life Members only will be allowed to participate in the companies.
- c) A Group of DFI Members with their own investments will float and run these commercial companies.
- d) 80% of the net profits will be shared by the investors in proportion to their investments as Dividends.
- e) 20% of profits will be donated to the DFI Trust for running the service activities.
- f) DFI with Its network of Branches/Members will help the commercial companies to market their goods and services.
- g) DFI will permit the companies to use its commercial logo to create Brand Image.
- h) DFI and DFI Group of companies will ultimately develop the Brahmin community into a strong force educationally and financially.

DFI has already set up a number of companies as per the details given below. In addition, an exclusive industrial zone is created in 400 acres of land in Kamareddy about 100 KMs from Hyderabad under **DHARANI** (Dhanwantari Foundation International Awaas Nirman) to facilitate Members to set up their own industries or participate in the industries being set up by DFI Group.
